| <p><b>On August 27, 2007 a limited edition of 100 covers</b> was flown from Edmonton to Cooking Lake, Alberta as a special project of the Western Chapter of the Canadian Aerophilatelic Society. These covers carry a specially designed Canadian Postage stamp commemorating the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the formation of the <i>Edmonton &amp; Northern Alberta Aero Club</i> and <i>Blatchford Field</i>, Edmonton. The covers are signed by Edmonton Flying Club instructor Audrey Kahovec and Student Pilot Denny May (son of the founder of the Flying Club). "Wop" May who made many of the original flights.</b> Two special postal cards. The stamps on these covers are postmarked and back-stamped at post offices currently serving the original communities. The Postmasters have all signed below their cancellations.</p> <p><b>Card 1:</b> Northern Alberta to South Mackenzie: Fort McMurray to Fort Chipewyan, Fort Fitzgerald, Fort Smith, Fort Resolution, Hay River, Fort Providence &amp; Fort Simpson.</p> <p><b>Card 2:</b> Mackenzie River to the high Arctic: Fort Simpson to Wrigley, Fort Norman, Fort Good Hope, Arctic Red River, Fort McPherson &amp; Aklavik.</p> <p>The Cards are included with the 11 page booklet which includes: The story of the early 1929 Airmail Flights to the Mackenzie River District; The story of the First Official Airmail Flights to the Arctic; Copies of the original announcements &amp; posters advertising the airmail service to the Mackenzie District; A complete listing of the 125 flights that took place in November &amp; December 1929 &amp; January 1930; A photo page of the pilots &amp; crew that were on the flights and a photo page of photos taken during the flights.</p> <p>The cards are mounted as a set in a 2 pocket philatelic quality plastic sleeve and the entire package is 3 hole punched &amp; distributed in a clear front presentation binder.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>postage included</i></p> | <p>At Feb 1/08 there are only 48 left</p> |  | <p>\$25.00</p> | <p>\$</p> |
